Purpose of Report:	To consider the grant application from Wareham Choral Society.			
Background:	The office received an email on 10 January 2024 enquiring whether the Town Council would like to sponsor Wareham Choral Society in providing a D-Day Commemorative Concert for Wareham. It was explained that the Council did not provide "sponsorship" but the society could apply for a grant which the Council would consider at its next meeting.			
Key Points:	The Choral Society submitted the following breakdown of receipts and payments, showing a deficit of £810, for the Council to consider.

	The grant budget line for 2023/24 financial year has £650 remaining following the award of grants in November 2023.			
Implications:	The D-Day Commemorative Concert aligns with preserving historical heritage, showcasing the town's commitment to remembering significant events and honouring those who served during wartime.			
	The Choral Society's proposed budget shows a deficit of $\pounds$ 810. The available grant budget for the 2023/24 financial year is $\pounds$ 650, which is insufficient to cover the entire deficit.			
Recommendation:	To consider the request from the Choral Society and agree whether to provide a grant or not, and if so, whether that should cover the deficit entirely or provide a portion of the deficit.
