

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF COW LANE, WAREHAM

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along Cow Lane, Wareham between Mill Lane and North Street (in both directions), a distance of approximately 75 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 9th June 2025 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 13th June 2025.

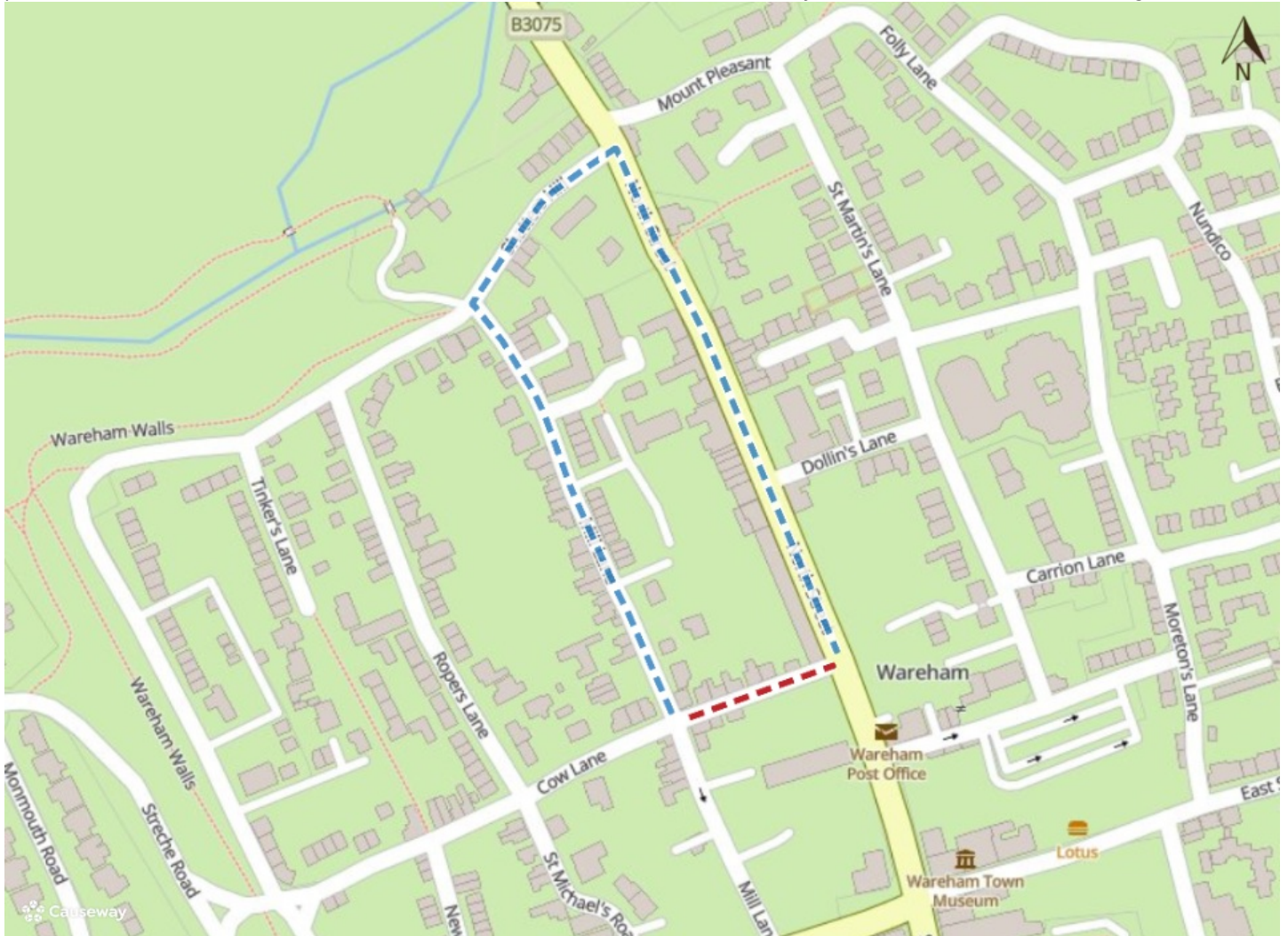
**This Notice will allow Bindon Abbey Scaffolding to erect scaffold to enable painting.**
