

FLAG FLYING

- (a) Flags are to be flown on all occasions recommended by HM Government on national occasions including royal birthdays and as amended from time to time.
- (b) the following occasions are also adopted for additional flag flying days:
- When twinning visits are in progress.
 - On Wareham Carnival days – to be applied for.
 - During Court Leet meeting in November (Court Leet to be consulted)
 - When Wareham in Bloom is being officially judged.
 - Guggenmusik Band events – to be applied for.
 - Visits of VIPs – consult with Town Clerk/Chairman of Amenities.
 - On official civic functions - Civic Service, Mayor's Civic Day and Remembrance Sunday - plus Mayor Making (Annual Town Council Meeting).
- (c) Organisations wishing to fly a flag from the Town Hall are to adhere to the following policy
- Applicants must complete a form obtainable from the Admin Office or downloadable from Council website.
 - Minimum of one month's notice for flag flying to be given plus any special requirements.
 - Full details of flag to be flown to be given e.g. size, quality, materials etc.
 - A stated period to be given for the flag flying request.
 - No national flags to be flown without the presence of the UK national flag.
 - Council will only supply flags that are in its possession, otherwise the organisation will be asked to provide their own.
 - All flags are subject to the approval of the Town Council who may decline to accept any flag submitted, this policy to be delegated to the Town Clerk who may consult with the Chairman of Amenities Committee as appropriate.
