

TEMPORARY CLOSURE VARIOUS ROADS, WAREHAM FOR A ST GEORGES DAY PARADE

DORSET COUNCIL has issued an Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to prohibit the use of the following roads by cyclists, horse riders and all mechanically propelled vehicles, except those taking part in the event and emergency vehicles, to facilitate a public event on the highway. The event will take place on **Sunday 27th April 2025 between 13:30 and 14:00.**

The following roads will be closed to facilitate the event:

[i] West Walls, Wareham from the junction with Cow Lane to North Walls; [ii] North Walls, Wareham from West Walls to Shatters Hill; [iii] Shatters Hill, Wareham from North Walls to the junction with B3075 North Street; [iv] B3075 North Street, Wareham from junction with Shatters Hill to B3075 South Street; [v] B3075 South Street, Wareham from B3075 North Street to the junction with St John's Hill [vi] St John's Hill, Wareham from junction with B3075 South Street; [vii] Church Green, Wareham in its entirety.

The road closure will be indicated by signage on site and will be lifted once the procession has past and it is safe to do so. There will no signed alternative route for traffic on this occasion. Marshalls will be stationed at strategic points to ensure only those taking part in the parade have access.
