

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MILL LANE, WAREHAM

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along Mill Lane, Wareham at the junction with Coopers Close (in both directions), a distance of approximately 10 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation between 09:30 until 16:00 on 15th January 2026 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 15th January 2026.

This Notice will enable Wessex Water safe access to undertake a Interim to Permanent Reinstatement.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: Shatters Hill, B3075 North Street, B3070 West Street, West Walls, Cow Lane and vice versa.
