TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT NOTICE VARIOUS ROADS, WAREHAM FOR WAREHAM CARNIVAL

DORSET COUNCIL has issued an Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to prohibit the use of the following roads by cyclists, horse riders and all mechanically propelled vehicles, except those taking part in the event and emergency vehicles, to facilitate a public event on the highway.

On Sunday 20th July 2025 between 11:00 and 16:00

The effect of this notice is as follows:

[i] To impose clearway and parking suspension as indicated by signs on site to prevent waiting or parking on the highway along Worgret Road between Streche Road to a point 150 metres west of the junction with Stowell Crescent to help the flow of the procession. This will be in operation between 09.00hrs – 17.00hrs. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by this Notice may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
