

EMERGENCY TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF B3070 WEST STREET, WAREHAM

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along B3070 West Street, Wareham between St Michaels Road and Mill Lane (in both directions) a distance of approximately 55 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It came in to operation on 15th June 2026 and can remain in force for up to 21 days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 19th June 2026.

This Notice will enable Scottish and Southern Power Distribution safe access to carry out emergency works to repair an electric cable.

A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed section.
