

EMERGENCY TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF HOWARDS LANE, WAREHAM

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along Howards Lane, Wareham from junction with North Street to a point 40 metres to the east. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It came in to operation on 7th January 2026 and can remain in force for up to 21 days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 9th January 2026.

This Notice will enable Wessex Water safe access to carry out emergency works to repair a leaking water pipe.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: Howards Lane, Moretons Lane, East Street, North Street and vice versa.
