

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ST MICHAELS ROAD, WAREHAM

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along St Michaels Road, Wareham between 5a St Michaels Road and 3 St Michaels Road (in both directions), a distance of approximately 20 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 11th May 2026 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 15th May 2026.

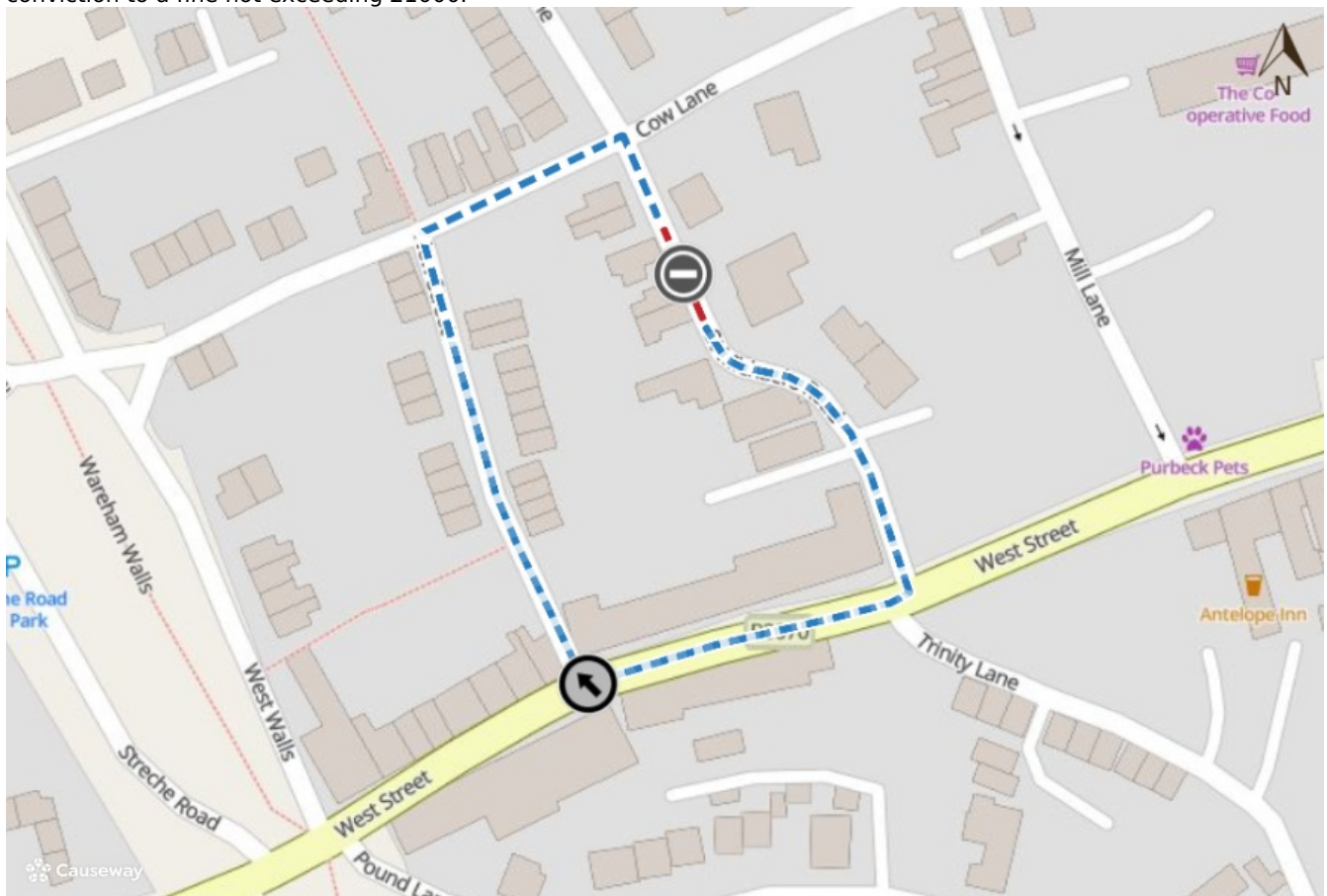
This Notice will provide Wessex Water and SSE with safe access to make a New Connection.
