

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER OF VARIOUS ROADS, WAREHAM & STOBOROUGH FOR WAREHAM WEDNESDAYS 2025

DORSET COUNCIL has issued an Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to prohibit the use of the following roads by cyclists, horse riders and all mechanically propelled vehicles, except those taking part in the event and emergency vehicles, to facilitate a public event on the highway. The restrictions will be in force on the following dates:

- 6th August 2025 (16.00 hrs to 23.59 hrs)
- 13th August 2025 (16.00 hrs to 23.59 hrs)
- 20th August 2025 (16.00 hrs to 23.59 hrs)
- 27th August 2025 (16.00 hrs to 23.59 hrs)

The effect of this order is as follows:

[1] To prohibit the use of Various Roads in Wareham as stated: [i] B3075 South Street, Wareham from junction with West Street to junction with B3075 South Causeway; [ii] B3075 South Causeway, Wareham & Stoborough from junction with B3075 South Street to outside 2 Corfe Road, Stoborough. Locally signed diversion routes will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed sections. Please note the closures will be in operation, as and when indicated by signs on site. Marshalls will be stationed at strategic points to ensure that only those involved with the event, residents, businesses and emergency services have access.

[2] To impose clearway and parking suspension as indicated by signs on site to prevent waiting or parking on the highway along Various Roads, Wareham as listed: [i] South Street, Wareham from junction with Abbots Quay to junction with Pound Lane; [ii] South Street, Wareham from outside 10a South Street to junction with West Street. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by this Notice may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.

[3] To prohibit the the use of The Quay Car Park, Wareham between 13.00 hrs and 23.59 hrs. Please note the closures will be in operation, as and when indicated by signs on site. Marshalls will be stationed at strategic points to ensure that only those involved with the event, residents, businesses and emergency services have access.
