Subject:	Cricket Wicket Replacement

Purpose of Report:	To consider the supplier for a replacement cricket wicket and recommend the expenditure to Full Council.	
Background:	The cricket wicket has served the Council for approximately a decade and has since degraded through normal use and unfortunate incidences of misuse and vandalism.	
	At the meeting of the Amenities Committee on 11 January 2023 a resolution was made to create a £6,000 budget provision for the 2024/25 financial year, and this was increased by £2,500 in the 2025/26 financial year budget.	
Key Points:	The reserve balance sits at £8500 for the replacement of the artificial cricket wicket for the 2025/26 financial year. Consideration for carrying out minor repairs as a cost-inefficient, short-term solution has been highlighted as likely needing frequent repetition. Whereas proposed replacements have lifespans of 10 – 12 years. It would be prudent to arrange for installation after the current cricket season once a company has been appointed. Correspondence with suppliers indicates this is achievable.	
	Two quotes for replacement of the entire artificial wicket, including Supplier 2's quote to replace the membrane of the top of the undamaged concrete underneath.	
	At the time of publishing this report a third supplier has been contacted on multiple occasions, but no quote has forthcoming from this firm.	
	Supplier 1	£9403
	Supplier 2	£8672
	The expenditure will exceed £5,000 and in line with Wareham Town Council's Financial Regulations, Full Council must authorise the commitment of this spend.	
Implications	The most cost-effective replacement of the wicket is approximately 2.02% overbudget and would require Council's approval for an unbudgeted spend in the sum of £172. Failure to replace the artificial cricket wicket may lead to decreased revenue generation from Wareham Town Council's cricketing facilities as clubs may avoid using the Recreation Ground.	
Recommendation	To recommend the selection of Supplier 2 to replace the artificial cricket wicket to Full Council for approval.
